What is the Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)?

The Senior Community Service Employment Program is a program through the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) that is funded under Title V of the Older Americans Act. The purpose of SCSEP are:

- To foster and promote useful part-time opportunities in community service activities for unemployed low-income persons who are age 55 or older and who have poor employment prospects;
- To foster individual economic self-sufficiency; and
- To assist older persons in transition to unsubsidized employment
