WHO IS NAPCA?
Established in 1978, the National Asian Pacific Center on Aging (NAPCA), is the leading national advocacy organization committed to the well-being of older Asian American and Pacific Islanders. NAPCA develops and administers programs which enhance the dignity and quality of life of its constituents.

NAPCA is a private, non-profit corporation headquartered in Seattle, Washington. NAPCA's major emphasis is on employment services for older workers; research and data collection; development and management of model projects; technical assistance to Asian American and Pacific Islander communities; and policy development on local, state and national levels.

WHAT IS SCSEP?

- The Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) is a U.S. Department of Labor funded employment and training program.
- NAPCA SCSEP concentrates on serving limited and non-English speaking Asian and Pacific Islander seniors.
- The goal of SCSEP is to help participants gain work experience and overcome barriers by receiving on-the-job training at not-for-profit, 501(c)(3) community based organizations or government agencies.
- The dual purpose of the SCSEP program is to provide community service while improving participants' job skills to enable them to find full or part-time unsubsidized employment.

CHINESE COMMUNITY CENTER operates SCSEP to provide talented, hardworking people to our host agencies. Together, we can offer opportunities that improve the job readiness of mature workers while expanding their service to the community.

Updates on SCSEP funding

Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP), a federal program funded by the U.S. Department of Labor, primary goal is to train, motivate, and empower participants on the path to unsubsidized employment and self-sufficiency. At this time, the funding for SCSEP is in jeopardy as the proposed "skinny budget" seeks the elimination of the program.

What does that mean for you as a SCSEP participant?

Learn and refine your skills as you actively look for a job. Take the opportunity to ask your supervisor to review your resume and assistance with your job search. Ask SCSEP staff for help with needed.

What does that mean for you as a SCSEP host agency?

Continue to support SCSEP by offering training on soft and hard skills that participants will need to transfer into long term employment opportunities. Share available positions at your agency to participants when they qualify. In addition to the critical training, participants gain confidence, motivation, and empowerment from their supervisors and co-workers.
