#### CELEBRATING A VISIONARY LEADER'S LIEFTIME ACHIEVEMENT

As we kick off this year's "Celebrating Changemakers: Honoree Spotlight" series, we are proud to highlight Chi-mei Lin, the esteemed CEO of the Chinese Community Center (CCC), who will be honored with the Lifetime Achievement Award at the Embracing Tomorrow's Harvest Gala on November 16, 2024. Chi-mei's illustrious 40-year career in human services and her 25 transformative years with CCC have left a profound mark on the community, inspiring countless individuals and shaping the Center's future.



#### >>> A DEVOTED SERVANT LEADER

Chi-mei's leadership is rooted in a lifelong commitment to serving those in need. From her early days in Massachusetts to her impactful tenure in Texas, she has worked tirelessly to uplift vulnerable communities, including at-risk youth, frail seniors, and individuals with disabilities. Since taking the helm at CCC in 2002, she has led CCC's Child Development Center to achieve national accreditation—an honor held by fewer than 5% of childcare centers in Houston. She also played a pivotal role in establishing the Financial Opportunity Center (FOC) within the Social Service Department and launched the state-of-the-art Senior Day Activity and Health Service (DAHS) program, helping countless families thrive post-pandemic.

### >>> A STRONG VOICE FOR THE ASIAN AMERICAN COMMUNITY

Beyond her role as CEO of the Chinese Community Center, Chi-mei is a fierce advocate for the Asian American community. She was instrumental in creating the Empower Community Initiative (ECI), a collective effort of 15 AAPI organizations committed to civic engagement and language justice in Houston. By securing national resources and building a strong local coalition, Chi-mei has ensured that Houston's Asian American voices are heard, represented, and empowered.



### >>> A DREAM BUILDER AND DELIVERER

Chi-mei's legacy is deeply tied to her visionary work in expanding CCC's impact. She worked closely with the CCC board to successfully complete the Capacity Building Campaign in 2005 and the New Horizon Campaign in 2019, raising a combined \$14 million for the Center's current campus. These efforts have cemented CCC's place as a leading community resource for generations to come.
