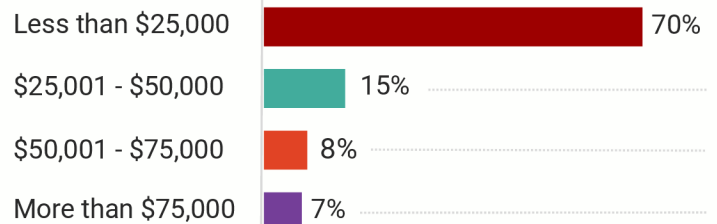

SOCIAL SERVICES: Strengthening financial stability & career advancement



\$2.95M

in Total Social Benefits secured through the Benefit Enrollment Center (BEC) for **2,011 households**, helping them stay financially stable.



\$125,000

in Down Payment Assistance awarded to a single Housing Program client; 14 families purchased their first homes; and **332 families** advanced toward homeownership.



\$1.13M

in Tax Refunds returned to families through **993 tax returns** prepared by the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program.

Total Employment:	193 (out of 350 clients)
Vocational Training:	88 participants
Wage Increase (Avg.):	46% (≈ \$10.2K annually)
Debt Reduction (Avg.):	\$3,187 per client
Savings Increase (Avg.):	\$5,750 per client

Senior Community Service Employment (SCSEP) Program

112 adults aged 55+ received paid on-the-job training instead of staying unemployed, completing **66,936 total work hours**; 8 seniors successfully transitioned to unsubsidized jobs.

EDUCATION: Helping children and youth learn, grow, and thrive

Clients Served in Youth Program **93.6%** of Youth in program increased their social-emotional learning skills; **89.7%** of parents maintained employment while children were enrolled in the Youth Program.

Clients Served in Childcare Program In our nationally accredited childcare program, **94%** of children met developmental milestones and were ready for school, while 100% of parents remained employed during their enrollment.
